**Re: Eagle Crest Energy Company, Eagle Mountain Pumped Storage Project,
FERC Project No. 13123; Application for License**

Dear Stakeholder:

On June 22, 2009, Eagle Crest Energy Company ("ECE") filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission" or "FERC"), a final license application for the Eagle Mountain Pumped Storage Project.

The Eagle Mountain Pumped Storage Project will use off-peak energy to pump water from the lower reservoir to the upper reservoir during periods of low electrical demand and generate on-peak energy by conveying water from the upper to the lower reservoir through the generating units during periods of high electrical demand. The upper and lower reservoirs will be formed from existing mining pits. The Project will nominally provide up to 1,300 MW of generating capacity, developed with four reversible pump-turbine units, with each unit rated at 325 MW under the maximum gross head (1,572 feet).

The public version of the final license application is available for viewing at the project website www.eaglecrestenergy.com.
